

Dr. Judit Boczán

Dr. Boczán Judit is a Hungarian neurologist and associate professor at the Department of Neurology of the University of Debrecen. Her clinical and research interests include neuromuscular disorders, clinical neurophysiology, neuroimmunology, and neurogenetics. She has extensive experience in the diagnosis and treatment of immune-mediated neurological diseases and paraneoplastic neurological syndromes, with a special focus on disorders of the neuromuscular junction.

She spent two years as a Fogarty Fellow at the National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke (NINDS), part of the National Institutes of Health (NIH), where she further advanced her research experience in clinical neuroscience and neurogenetics.

In addition to her clinical and scientific work, she is actively involved in medical education, teaching neurology to both Hungarian and international medical students. She is also a regular speaker at national and international scientific conferences. Dr. Boczán currently serves as the president of the Hungarian Clinical Neurogenetics Society.
