

Prof. Michelangelo Mancuso is an associate professor of neurology at the University of Pisa (Italy).

Graduated in Medicine in 1996, he specialized at the University of Pisa in 2000 and completed his training at Columbia University in New York. He also obtained his PhD at the University of Pisa in 2004.

He mainly deals with neuromuscular and rare neurological diseases, including mitochondrial diseases.

Currently Prof. Mancuso is the Director of the Interdepartmental Research Centre for Translational Medicine in Neuromuscular and Mitochondrial Diseases at the University of Pisa, and chair of the neuromuscular service at the Neurological Clinic of the Azienda Ospedaliera Universitaria Pisana.

Member of prestigious scientific societies, he is author of numerous more than 350 publications (H-index=60) and has participated, also as organizer, in national and international congresses.

Prof. Mancuso is the Past-Coordinator of the study group of Clinical Neurogenetics and Rare Diseases of the Italian Society of Neurology and past coordinator of the Rare diseases coordinating panel of the European Academy of Neurology. He is also chairman of the Mitochondrial Group of the ERN-NMD, together with [Cornelia Kornblum](#), and chair of the InterERN group on mitochondrial diseases.
